



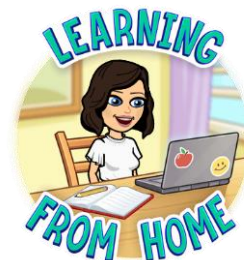
# Five Ways Primary School

I will try to follow our class timetable as much as possible. The PIN and password for our Zoom meetings will remain the same but I will post these on our Google Classroom Stream as a reminder.

If you are attending school over the next few weeks and therefore, will not be able to access the English and Maths Zoom calls during the mornings, I will be running a Zoom call on a **Monday afternoon at 4.30pm** so that we can keep in touch and chat about what you have been up to at school. This zoom call will also give you the opportunity to ask any questions and share any learning with me that you are proud of. We may also play a couple of games! The pin and password for this will remain the same as the other Zoom calls but I will be sending an email out outlining the details of this.

When you log onto a Zoom, please make sure you are organised with paper/home-learning books and a pen or pencil and that you have a quiet place to work. It may also be useful to use headphones so that you can hear me as clearly as possible and have your own microphone muted until invited to speak or answer a question.
