I am so excited to say that this is our final week of learning via Zoom – I cannot wait to see you all on Monday 8th March! 😊 This week, I have been making sure I am being much more active and I have set myself a challenge to reach 10,000 steps or more every day. I have been walking on my lunch breaks and after my dinner, and some days I have been going out to run 5km. Taking frequent brain breaks is really important for our mental health and well-being as it breaks up our screen time.

Next week is World Book Week 2021 and Thursday 4th March is World Book day! Over the course of the week, we will be learning how to write in the style of Liz Pichon – who is the author of the Tom Gates series of books. I know that many of you really enjoy reading Tom Gates books and so I expect this week will be really fun for everyone! ***As Thursday 4th March is World Book Day, our Zooms will be a little different for this day only. Our first Zoom will be at 9am as a whole class as usual. Our second Zoom will again be as a whole class at 11am. There will be no maths zoom or maths learning set on this day, instead we will be doing two English based zoom sessions with some fun games and activities to celebrate World Book Day. If you are attending school as part of a key worker bubble group at the moment, you are invited to dress up as your favourite book character if you would like to. If you are learning from home, you can dress up if you would like to but this is not an expectation as only your head and shoulders are seen on the Zoom call. If you would prefer to wear a mask of your favourite book character or wear a hat to represent your character, then this is okay too. Alternatively, you don't have to dress up at all if you would not like to 😊***


