

Well done on another successful week! Lots of learning this week and it is super to be able to see your work appear on my screen and to give you that feedback. Well done for winning our Year 5 TT Rockstar battle! Don't forget our next battle against Mr Doughty's class is already live and finishes on Thursday at 6pm.



We will continue our zooms sessions as normal at 9.30am and 11am. Your independent tasks will be set via Google Classroom and go 'live' at the start of each zoom session. Please remember on our zoom calls to make sure you have a pencil and paper at the ready and you remember it as a 'virtual' classroom. It is important we continue to follow any instructions I give or complete any little activities we do during these calls.



We continue our focus on fantasy stories in English. If you haven't already - start to jot down some ideas about your fantasy story. I'm sure some of you have created some super story maps which will help structure your stories. This week we will be looking at 'Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone' by JK Rowling. A reminder to keep reading independently and keeping those reading entries in your home-link books updated.

In maths, we will be continuing our formal written methods for multiplication. I will continue to add extra support via YouTube clips on some days. It will give you chance to: work with me at the same time, pause and complete calculations ahead of me and take it at your own speed. It also means you can re-watch the video and adults can also see the strategies we are using. Keep up with those times tables: <u>Aim to spend 10 minutes each day (at least) on TTRockstars.</u> Remember there are additional consolidation packs uploaded to the school website which revise the units covered in the autumn term from a problem-solving perspective.

The foundation subject tasks will become 'live' on Google Classroom each Monday at 11am. This will allow you to organise which tasks you complete on which days across the week. All tasks have been given a week's due date so that you have plenty of time to complete the tasks set. RSPB Great British Bird Watch 29th- 31st January

Join the RSPB for the Big Garden Birdwatch and discover the drama on your doorstep. The great thing is that you never know what birds you might see. Will you enjoy a flock of fluffed-up long-tailed tits, will you be charmed by a group of goldfinches or will a cheeky robin steal the show?

Please note, there will be a live lesson from BBC based on the Great British Bird Watch at 11am on the 28th January. Although you will not be able to watch live as we will be having our maths lesson, I have uploaded the link for you to watch another time. There is also an activity sheet to go alongside this lesson. Please see Google Classroom for lots of different activities for you to have a go at, including some links to some fun websites. This is a project so can run over the week.

### DT – linked to RSPB Bird Watch Project

As this week is the RSPB Great British Bird Watch, why don't you encourage birds into your garden and help them by feeding them over the winter months. Watch this <u>video</u> then challenge yourself to make your own bird feeder using recycling materials. You could upload a picture of your bird feeder by clicking the 'add' button and uploading a picture from your drive.

### Science – New Topic – The Heart and Circulation

Lesson 1 - What happens to the circulatory system during exercise? (thenational.academy)

Watch and interact with the lesson which will teach you about the parts of the human circulatory system.

Learn how to locate and take your resting heart rate. If you have a fitness app or smart watch you could use this but do learn to locate the pulse on your wrist. The movement you feel is the blood pumping through your blood vessels!

- Measure your heart rate at rest and after exercise as shown in the film clip.
- What other changes can you observe in your body as you exercise?
- You could try different types/intensities of exercise to see the impact this has on your heart rate.

<u>Challenge:</u> Find out how long it takes for your pulse rate to return to normal following exercise.
