Hello to you all, Bears!

It was lovely to see most of you on zoom last week and I am super impressed with your attitude to learning and how well you have been accessing and completing your learning on Google Classroom. You make me very proud to be your teacher.



As mentioned in our zoom call on Thursday, live zoom lessons will change slightly from next week, this is to enable smaller, more focused groups for Maths. From Monday to Thursday, we will trial continuing with whole class English lessons daily at the new time of 9:15am, then splitting into two groups for Maths at 10:30am and 11am. Details of the maths groups will be communicated in the zoom call on Monday and published on the class stream within Google Classroom. Each Friday, we will meet as a whole class at 9:15 and again at 10:30, the sessions on a Friday may alternate between a Maths or English or a guided skills lesson on how to utilise features on Google Classroom to complete assignments that have been set for English, Maths or the wider curriculum. One of our Friday sessions may include a fun session which we can discuss as a class from next week.

If anyone is having trouble accessing their Google Classroom account and would like further support then please email me on GoogleClassroom5JK@fiveways.staffs.sch.uk and I will try and address any issues you may be having.

As a reminder, during our daily zoom lessons, I will go over the learning task so that you are all clear on what to do and can ask any questions that you may have. Each Zoom call will be roughly 30 minutes. When you log onto a zoom, please make sure you are organised with paper/home-learning books and a pen or pencil and that you have a quiet place to work. It may also be useful to use headphones so that you can hear me as clearly as possible and have your own microphone muted until invited to speak or answer a question. The details of the Zoom meeting ID and password will be published on Google Classroom. Again, if you have difficulty accessing this then please email GoogleClassroom5JK@fiveways.staffs.sch.uk.

In addition to the Maths tasks, I would also like you to use 'Hit the Button' website <https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button> and times table rock stars www.ttrockstars.co.uk to keep those number facts both quick and accurate! I will be announcing Times Table Rockstar Headliners in class when we return.

Remember to logon to BugClub to read books from your assigned book band. I will be keeping track and rewarding those who have completed books and quizzes like I do in class.




