Dear Eagles,

Thank you to all those who have been able to attend Zoom meetings this week. It has been wonderful to see you all after the Christmas break. I have been very impressed with how you have settled into the 'live lessons' and how sensible you have been. Thank you for being organised with bringing what you need to each lesson. It really does help. I can see that many of you have been completing the work on line. I would like to say a big 'thank you' to all of the parents and other adults at home who are setting up your Zoom calls and supporting you with your home learning.

Our home learning journey is going to continue next week and I look forward to teaching you every day via Zoom. We will continue to meet as a whole class at 9:30 a.m. for registration and morning activities, followed by a first lesson. After a break to allow you to do your independent work from lesson 1, we will all meet again at 11:30 a.m. for a second lesson, followed by an independent task. After lunch, you will have time to complete any work set that morning in maths or English lessons, then either complete the timetabled work for science or topic, or a lesson of your choice from those given. This letter includes details of other timetabled lessons, and choice lessons. Each day it is expected that you complete your maths and English tasks from that day's Zoom lessons, plus at least one additional lesson of science, topic, French, music, RE or Art. Any work that has been asked to be 'turned in' on Google Classroom needs to be done so by 3:45 pm please.

Don't forget to try to exercise for at least 1 hour per day. Joe Wicks has re-launched his workouts on his YouTube Channel that are about 20 minutes long. New ones are posted on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

Each Zoom lesson will be roughly 30 minutes. When you log onto a zoom, please make sure you are organised with paper/home-learning books and a pen or pencil and that you have a quiet place to work. Please also ensure that you are sat upright and that you have a desk / table to work at or something hard (like a book) to lean on to complete the interactive part of our Zoom lessons. It may also be useful to use headphones so that you can hear me as clearly as possible and have your own microphone muted until invited to speak or answer a question. (Also make sure that you have been to the toilet before the lesson starts so that you do not need to go in the middle of it).
