As a quick reminder, on Friday the main spelling group will have their English lesson (Spellings) straight after maths. They will have a short refreshment break before we carry out the spelling test. <u>The SNIP group will have their spelling Zoom lesson at 11am.</u>

As always, make sure you are organised before you log onto your Zoom lessons, with things like pen, paper, and completed tasks, and remember to go to the toilet if you need to before the lesson starts. Try hard to remember to have your device charged before the lessons begin and please do not turn your video off since it is important for me to know that you are in the lesson.
