

Your independent tasks will be set via Google Classroom and go 'live' at the start of each zoom session. Please remember on our zoom calls to have a pencil and paper at the ready. You know the routine by now!

In English, we will be looking at autobiographies and celebrating all things 'Tom Gates by Liz Pichon' as

our chosen author. On Thursday 4th March, it is World Book day! Children who attend a bubble in school are invited to come to school dressed up as a character from a book if they want to. Children at home are invited to dress up too for our Zoom calls. This is optional. If you are finding it tricky to source a costume, you could make a hat, glasses or a mask to wear – or draw a picture of a
