

## Outdoor Challenge 6 – How many items can you fit into a small box, container or envelope?

1 – Ask an adult to help you find or make ONE of the below:

- A small container (e.g. the lid of a deodorant)
- A small box about the size of a small matchbox
- A small envelope

Don't make it too big – it spoils the fun!!

2 – Go out into the garden and collect as many small things that you can find. They all need to fit in the container. They have to be whole things – you cannot have a leaf and tear a piece off or break a bit of a stick! It has to be the whole leaf or the whole stick!

\*\*Use your observation skills along with your thinking skills to find tiny things.

\*\*If you don't have a garden, you can carry this out in the house.

\*\*Have a family competition – its great fun! You will be amazed at what you can find.

We did this in school and the highest amount of items we had in one small deodorant lid was 44. See if you can beat it!
