
Roman Soldier Paper Model



- 1. Carefully cut out Part A, making sure to cut along all thick black lines, including those that go into the design near tabs 3 and 5.
- 2. Fold each dotted line in a hill fold or valley fold according to the key.
- 3. Next, carefully cut out Part B and fold according to the key. Make sure to cut along all thick black lines, including the lines into the feet and at the top of half of each leg.
- 4. Add some glue to tab 1 and glue to the top of the large section on Part B, between tabs 6 and 7.
- 5. Next, glue tabs 2 and 3 to the inside of the body piece near tabs 6 and 7.
- 6. Add some glue to tabs 4 and 5 and glue to the curved flaps on the arm pieces.
- 7. Add some glue to tab 8 and stick to the underside of the section with tab 9.
- 8. Next, glue tabs 6 and 7 to the curved sections on the arms.
- 9. Add some glue to tab 9 and stick to the underside of the front body of the soldier to connect Parts A and B together.

- 10. Add some glue on the undecorated side of the legs and stick the two sides together to create each leg.
- 11. Carefully cut out Part C. Make sure to cut around all solid lines, including the small curved line around tabs 10 and 11.
- 12. Glue tabs 10 and 11 to the back of the soldier's helmet.
- 13. Glue tab 12 to the underside of the soldier's face.
- 14. Next, glue the sides of the soldier's helmet to tabs 13 and 14 on the body's shoulders. Make sure the face is facing towards the front (where the decorative flap is).
- 15. Finally, cut out the spear and add some glue about halfway down, sticking it to the soldier's right hand.

You soldier is now finished and ready to fight for the glory of Rome!
