## Dear Parents,

We are continuing to work extremely hard to allow your children access to google classrooms. This will initially be in the form of providing pre-recorded videos from class teachers on there, but we will update you on this in the coming days. If you haven't already, please could you log in to your child's account with the details provided before Christmas and familiarise yourself with the layout. The children should be able to show you where all the key sections are, as we talked about this in class before the Christmas holidays. We understand that as parents you may still be working from home, many of you full time, and home learning will pose challenges. If you are unable to attend zoom sessions, please do not worry. The timetable for learning suggests times similar to the school routine however these can be adapted to suit your day. Many of us are in the same position with small children at home and we fully understand your day may look different to our suggestion. In line with government guidance, we are required to keep track of the children's Zoom attendance and the work we see, this is not to put pressure on you but to provide a duty of care to the children. If we have not seen your child on a Zoom call, nor have we received any work from you over the course of the week we are required to make a pastoral phone call to check on the wellbeing of your child. Please do not be concerned if you receive these calls, they are not in any way negative.

Areas of learning:	Activity:		
Science	Our new science topic is term is 'Animals including Humans'. We are going to begin by watching some videos on BBC Bitesize including:  What are mammals?  What are amphibians?  What are fish?  What are reptiles?  What are mini beasts?  Please scroll down to the sub heading 'Animals' and only watch these videos, please do not watch any more as they are needed later on in the topic.  https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/subjects/z6svr82  Once you have watched the video, please go to the science section of this week's home learning and complete the activity titled 'Common Animals'.		
Topic	Following on from last week's lesson of locating London on a map, this week can you use Goggle Maps to explore London. Can you find some of the monuments that we have talked about this week in English?  Buckingham Palace, Trafalgar Square or maybe St Paul's Cathedral.  Once you have explored London using Google Maps, there is a map on the website for you to use and construct basic symbols in key form. Can you draw a picture of each of the monuments where they should be located on the map?  Also attached is a completed map for you to check your answers once you have finished.
