

MATHEMATICS

Recognise, order and write numbers to 20 and count out the correct number of objects.

Begin to use the language of subtraction in practical situations. E.g. "I have 10 bananas and I eat 2. How many do I have left?"

Measure in different ways, for example ordering the dinosaurs by size and measuring how tall they are using cubes.



LITERACY

Recognise and write all Phase 3 sounds and tricky words, e.g. 'she', 'was', 'are'.

Begin to read and write simple sentences.

Take part in guided reading sessions when I will read captions, poems and rhymes with the help of my teacher.

Know that I can find information about dinosaurs from books.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

Know that children around the world have different traditions and celebrations such as 'Chinese New Year' and 'Easter'.

Sort different jungle animals and dinosaurs and use the internet to find out about how they are different and the same, including what they look like and eat.

Complete a computer programme independently, such as a phonics sorting game on 'Espresso'.



EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

Create a Chinese Dragon dance, learning how to move to the rhythm of the music.

Act out some traditional tales such as 'Jack and the Beanstalk' taking on different roles.

Join in with small world play and make up a story using the dinosaurs, listening to my friends ideas.

Design and make moving dinosaur and traditional tale puppets using split pins independently.
