Know one more and one less than a number to 20.

Use solid objects to help me solve problems when adding and subtracting.

Know doubles and halves to 20 and use my knowledge when solving number problems.

Measure in lots of different ways, such as weighing the toy sea creatures using the large balance scales outside.



LITERACY

Form all my letters correctly with good presentation.

Write sentences independently which can be read by someone else.

Spell more 'tricky' words.

Be independent and use tricky words I have learnt to spell and spell them correctly in my writing.

Read with more fluency, recognising more words by sight and talk about what I have read with understanding.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

Learn about the life cycles of different animals by hatching chicks and a visit to the farm.

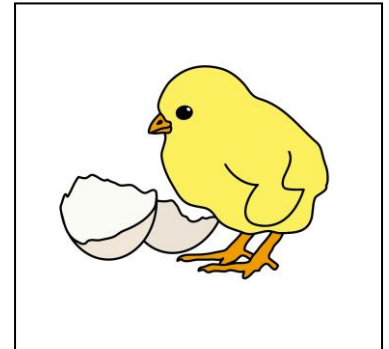
Notice similarities and differences between animals, for instance sorting the farm animals using different criteria.

Bake some cakes and talk about how the mixture changes when it is cooked.

Talk about changes that happen in the Summer time, such as the weather and plants which grow.

Program the 'Bee-bot' to move around an obstacle course.

Use the camera to take photographs which interest me or to record what I have created, such as a model of a tractor.



EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN



Use collage materials such as pasta, seeds and vegetables to investigate texture and create pictures of sea creatures.

Use pencils, paint and pastels to create observational drawings of flowers after looking at famous paintings of flowers such as Van Gogh's 'Sunflowers.'

Play different percussion instruments, playing loudly, quietly, fast, slow and be able to keep a steady beat.

Take part in role-play to act out a story, such as performing jobs on the farm or visiting the farm shop to buy vegetables.
