

Water balloons Phonics

Week beg: 4th May



For this phonics activity you need to fill some balloons with water and write words on them.

The children have to read the word then if they get it correct they can then throw the balloon at a wall to break it!

For an extension:

You can write the ending of the words on the balloon e.g. at for s a t

Then have letters along the wall in chalk or on paper.

The children then pick a water balloon and hold it up against one of the letters on the wall to

see if the letter and word ending match to make a word.

If it does, they have to read the word out loud, and then they get to throw the balloon at the letter to pop it.

Examples of words to use:

Phase 2

cat him bat jet man cot big leg

Phase 3

chin bath rain moon cart star

Phase 4

jump slip flat melt plan damp
