



Maths

In maths, we are studying number. We will use concrete apparatus to add, subtract, multiply and divide 1-digit and 2-digit numbers. We will start learning multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

You can help your child by encouraging them to develop quick recall of number bonds to 10 and 20, and some bonds to 100. You can also help them to learn times tables facts for 2, 5 and 10 by accessing Times Tables Rockstars. Keep the mental maths challenges we send for homework and create a toolkit for your child to use at home.



<u>English</u>

During English lessons, we will retell a story. We will write a letter and a set of instructions. We will extend our use of punctuation and start to use question marks, exclamation marks and commas in lists. We will use a wider range of conjunctions to link ideas in our sentences, e.g. 'and, but, because.' We will identify nouns, adjectives and verbs in texts and in our own writing.

You can help your child by asking them questions about the text when they read and by challenging them to point to the answer in the text. Talk about the punctuation and grammar (nouns, adjectives and verbs) in the texts you read.



PSHE, HRE

During PSHE and HRE lessons, and during our daily assemblies, we will share stories that help us to understand our British Values, including 'mutual respect' and 'individual liberty'.

You can help your child by chatting about our diverse society and the importance of treating one another with respect.

RE

In RE we will consider how special Jesus is to Christians. We will look at images, read stories and listen to carols.



Scienc

In science, we will be finding out how to be healthy and talking about a balanced diet and the importance of daily exercise. We will make a healthy snack.

In computing, we will learn to create, test and debug algorithms.
