Mathematics 	<p>This term I am learning to:</p> <p>Continue to develop strategies for adding and subtracting 2-digit numbers including partitioning, number lines and column methods.</p> <p>Investigate the relationship between addition and subtraction and use this to solve missing number problems, e.g. $__ - 14 = 28$.</p> <p>Know multiplication facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.</p> <p>Solve two-step problems using addition and subtraction.</p>
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English 	<p>This term I am learning to:</p> <p>Answer inference and deduction questions about texts, making my answers clear and sufficiently detailed.</p> <p>Use a wide range of punctuation accurately in my independent writing, including capital letters (for people, places and 'I'), full stops, exclamation marks and questions marks.</p> <p>Use a wide range of conjunctions in my independent writing, especially 'and, but, because, when, if, that, or.'</p> <p>Apply my knowledge of spelling accurately in my written work, including common exception words, contractions and words ending in suffixes such as 'ly, ness, less, ment, ful'.</p> <p>Form letters of the correct size during all of my written work, positioning all letters on the line and making ascenders (tall letters) and descenders (hanging letters), really clear.</p>
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Subject	This term I am learning to:
Science 	Learn about the life cycles and habitats of different animals.
Computing 	Explore uses of technology for communication.
Topic: History 	Research locally, nationally and internationally significant people in history.
Topic: Geography 	Find out about climate and weather.
Religious Education 	Find out about how Christians and Muslims welcome children into their faith community.
Design & Technology 	Develop some basic sewing skills.
Art 	Experiment with wax resist techniques when painting.

Music		Sing folk songs and listen to music of other cultures adding percussion instruments to accompany class singing. Extend my learning about timbre, tempo and dynamics. Understand how sounds can be combined to create a class composition.
