Week Commencing: Monday 13th July 2020

This week we are continuing to learn about fables.

Weekly Spelling (pick one per day)

- Woops! Miss Pearsall dropped all the letters to this week's spellings. Three words got mixed up. Can you unscramble them?
EDIUG, WARDFOR, SSDDARE
- Make a poster to help you learn this week's spellings: address, centre, early, forward, guide, medicine.
- Use each of the words in a sentence.
- You could draw a little picture, sketch, icon or image to help you remember the meaning of the word.
- Look, **say**, cover, write, check each spelling or ask a grown up to 'quiz' you on the spellings

Weekly SPAG / Reading / Speaking and Listening (pick one per day)

- Go onto BBC fables website <https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/english-ks1--ks2-aesops-fables-index/z73s6v4> and listen to a fable of your choice. There are 40 to choose from. Tell a grown up about the story and discuss the Moral.
- Go onto BBC fables website above and listen to The Ant and the Grasshopper.
- After listening to the Ant and the Grasshopper fable please discuss the answers to the following questions with a grown up or sibling:
 - Why doesn't the grasshopper want to work, like the ant is working?
 - Why doesn't the ant want to laze around, like the grasshopper is doing?
 - Why is the ant dragging food to its nest?
 - When winter comes, how come the ant is not starving like the grasshopper?
 - Why won't the ant share its food with the grasshopper?
 - What do you think will happen to the grasshopper next?
- Complete The Ant and the Grasshopper reading comprehension sheet. I suggest you try the 2 or 3 star sheet.
- Read a book on Bug Club and answer all the questions behind the bugs.

- Complete the Ant and the Grasshopper word search.
- Make the Ant and the Grasshopper stick puppets.

- Practise your cursive handwriting on the Ant and the Grasshopper sheet.
