This week we are continuing to learn about fables.

Weekly Spelling (pick one per day)	Weekly SPAG / Reading / Speaking and Listening (pick one per day)
 Woops! Mrs Marsh dropped all the letters to this week's spellings. Three words got mixed up. Can you unscramble them? ELCRIC NIETERTS, UTEMIN Make a poster to help you learn this week's spellings: busy, circle, exercise, heard, interest, minute. Use each of the words in a sentence. You could draw a little picture, sketch, icon or image to help you remember the meaning of the word. Look, say, cover, write, check each spellings For my SNIP spelling group here are this weeks spellings: brother, because, another, called, little. Some of the tricky words from previous weeks have been repeated. Can you still spell them? Please use the activities above to help you learn these words. 	 Go onto BBC fables website https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school- radio/english-ks1ks2-aesops-fables- index/z73s6v4 and listen to a fable of your choice. There are 40 to choose from. Tell a grown up about the story and discuss the Moral. Go onto BBC fables website above and listen to The Lion and The Mouse fable. Now act out the fable as a family. You could play more than 1 character if needed. After listening and acting out The Lion and the Mouse Fable please discuss the answers to the following questions with a grown up or sibling: Why does the mouse climb onto the lion? • How does the mouse persuade the lion not to eat him? • Why does the lion choose not to eat the mouse? • Why is it such an amusing thought for the lion that the mouse could ever help him? • How does the lion end up needing the mouse's help? • How is the mouse able to help? Complete The Lion and The Mouse reading comprehension sheet. I suggest you try the 1 or 2 star sheet. Read a book on Bug Club and answer all the questions behind the bugs. Please practise your cursive handwriting. Trace over the words from The Lion and The Mouse 	 Weekly Mathematics (pick one per day) This week I would like you to look at the different lines in shapes. Look through the lines in our environment PowerPoint. Make a list of the vertical and horizontal lines you can see in your house and garden. You could also go for a walk and write down any vertical or horizontal lines you see on your walk. Work your way through the horizontal and vertical lines PowerPoint and complete the
