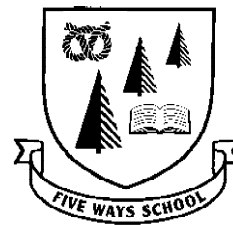

Objectives:

Convert between different units of measure, e.g. kilometre to metre.

Begin to solve two-step money and measurement problems involving decimals to two places.

Develop my understanding of 12 hour digital time and begin to understand 24 hour digital time.

Interpret information presented in bar charts, pictograms, tables and other graphs.

Describe positions on a 2-D grid as coordinates in the first quadrant.

Compare and classify geometric shapes, including quadrilaterals and triangles, based on their properties.

Read Roman numerals to 100 (I to C).

Subject	Objectives
Science 	Group animals into vertebrates and invertebrates. Identify the features of each vertebrate group. Recognise how environments can change.
Computing 	Write and present a questionnaire for the collection of information. Use the information collected to test a simple hypothesis.
Topic 	Learn about the features of rivers, how they are created and how they change over time. Learn about the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain.
Religious Education 	Understand the value that a title holds, e.g. Sir, Lady and Your Honour.
Design & Technology 	Learn about pulleys and produce a battery-powered buggy.
Art 	Use perspective in landscape paintings and drawings. Create a sculpture using natural materials.
Music 	Sing songs from memory with emphasis on performance. Control pitch, tone and dynamics to create mood and atmosphere for an audience.
Modern Foreign Languages 	Investigate life in different regions of France.
Physical Education 	Develop a good throwing and batting technique. Learn a variety of athletic techniques including javelin throwing, sprinting and long jump.
