Students could pay one pound each to aim wet sponges at a member of Ramsway's staff.

"I must say I was a little nervous about this one at first," said a rather wet Mr Parkinson, "but since it's for charity I was happy to be a part of the fun." This particular charity has a special importance for the pupils at Ramsway, as one of their classmates, Sophia Martin, attends the Disability Support Unit once a fortnight. "I love going to St. Mary's," Sophia told the Ramsway Herald. "There are loads of fun activities, like wheelchair basketball."

Homework will be set on Monday and completed for the following Monday.


On Monday your child's class teacher will go through the completed homework with the class and your child will mark it themselves.
