I would like you to complete the learning in the order I have set it as some of the lessons follow on from one another. We will be completing the objectives that we would have completed if in school and I would like you to bring any work completed back in with your after half term.

For maths, we have 3 objectives on our 'Addition and Subtraction' unit to complete. I have uploaded work for all three objectives. Each lesson pack has a brief explanation and is then split into three levels of learning. You need to choose from the 2 or 3 star questions. Then the next day or session, complete the problem solving and reasoning activity to deepen your understanding. I have also set some My Maths work if you need anything extra. Thursday 15th October: Writing Task

Thursday is writing day! This week's writing focus is using relative clauses. We have been using them lots in our English books and for homework and now you need to include them into your writing.

So – today's task is to first design your own 'freakshake'. There are examples below. I would like you to design you own and then write about it using relative clauses. Use the blank cup to design yours and then write your sentences. It can be as creative and even as magical as you like. I have started a description as an example. Your writing should describe each layer using relative clauses. I realise this is a mouth-watering challenge and if you have the ingredients to hand maybe you could make your own version as a reward once you have completed your writing...yum! You can complete your writing on the computer or as a written piece.



You must remember:

- Your relative clauses must start with: that, which, whose, whom, who (however as you are describing an object you will need to stick to just <u>that</u> and <u>which</u>)
- They must be punctuated with either dashes, brackets or commas.
- Your sentence must still make sense without the embedded clause.
- Please circle your relative pronouns in your writing so they are clear to spot. Try to use at least 3 in your writing.
