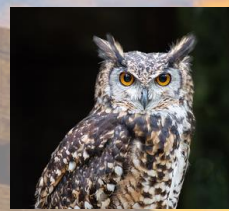
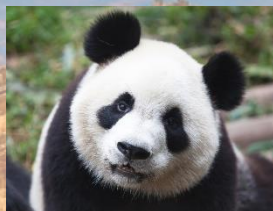
- Respond to our class novel: The Titanic Detective Agency by Lindsay Littleton.

In Year Five, we are learning to...

Maths

- Develop rapid recall of the multiplication facts and their related division facts.
- Recall square and cube numbers.
- Know and begin to use the vocabulary of prime numbers and prime factors.
- Multiply and divide numbers by 10, 100 and 1000.
- Solve two step problems, deciding which operations to use and why.

PE

- Develop flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance through gymnastics.
- Develop a broader range of techniques and skills for attacking and defending in INVASION GAMES : netball and basketball

Art - MAN-MADE OBJECTS

- Develop my sketching skills by making observational drawings of manmade object such as shoes and watches.
- Sketch, shade and add details.

MFL

- Ask about and describe the weather.
- Count higher and recognise the difference in phonic pronunciation, e.g. 'oi' = 'wah' sound.

Music – Christmas performance

- To perform as an ensemble.
- To learn songs for Christmas performance.

DT – Torches

- Investigate how torches are constructed.
- Learn how to construct simple electrical circuits and make a switch.

Computing

- Explore flat-file databases— simple systems for storing and organising information in rows and columns.

RE - Peace

- To discuss what makes us feel at peace.
- Explore symbols of peace in different faith communities.

How can you help at home?

- Listen to your child read at least 3 times a week.
- Encourage your child to log on to our online platforms and complete activities – Google classroom, TTRockstars, mymaths, Bug Club.
- Practise spellings regularly.

Health and Relationships Education (HRE)

- Explore different types of bullying, the impact of bullying, the responsibilities of bystanders and how to get help.
- Manage conflict, how to manage situations and how to seek help or advice from others, if needed.

Science – Earth and Space

- Describe the movement of the Earth in relation to the Sun.
- Describe the movement of the Moon in relation to the Earth.
- Explain the why we have seasons.
- Explain why the sun appears to move across the sky.
- Explain why we have shadows and why they change in length.

History – The Ancient Maya

- Know when the Maya Civilisation existed and where they are placed amongst a chronological framework, including the periods of British world history studied in KS2.
- Explore what the Maya civilisation was like using evidence and sources left behind.
