Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- Learning to talk to my friends about the ways we play together.
- Learning to use words when I am upset or frustrated.

You can help me by:

- Encouraging to negotiate and put across my own point of view
- Talking to me about naming the causes of my emotions

Literacy:

- Beginning to blend sounds I have learnt.
- Beginning to give meaning to the marks I make.
- Learning to hold a pencil or tool with a preferred hand.

You can help me by:

- Playing eye spy with me.
- Encouraging me to turn the pages when we read together and continue to walk my fingers beneath the text.
- Encourage me when holding pencils
- , and tools to make marks, paint or colour.

Communication and Language:

- Retelling familiar traditional tales.
- Learning new vocabulary related to Easter, spring and traditional tales.
- Use talk to organise our play.

You can help me by:

- Practising the rhymes in my rhyme book each week.
- Talking to me about my favourite stories and asking me to recall some of the characters.
- When I am playing, ask me open-ended questions about what I am doing.

Traditional Tales and Spring

You can help me by:

- Giving me opportunities to sing as often as possible.
- Help me to label the emotions I give people as I draw.
