Assistant Headteacher

Our Nursery is led by a qualified teacher and three early years practitioners.

There is one large space, which can be split into two rooms when required, in addition to this space we have two smaller rooms which are designed for small group work, quiet times such as story time and yoga; as well as for sensory play and activities involving cooking.

All children will be assigned a key worker adult who will become your 'go to' adult should you need to share information or seek advice.

Mrs Hill's office is based at the front of the school, near to the main office and close to the Nursery setting.


