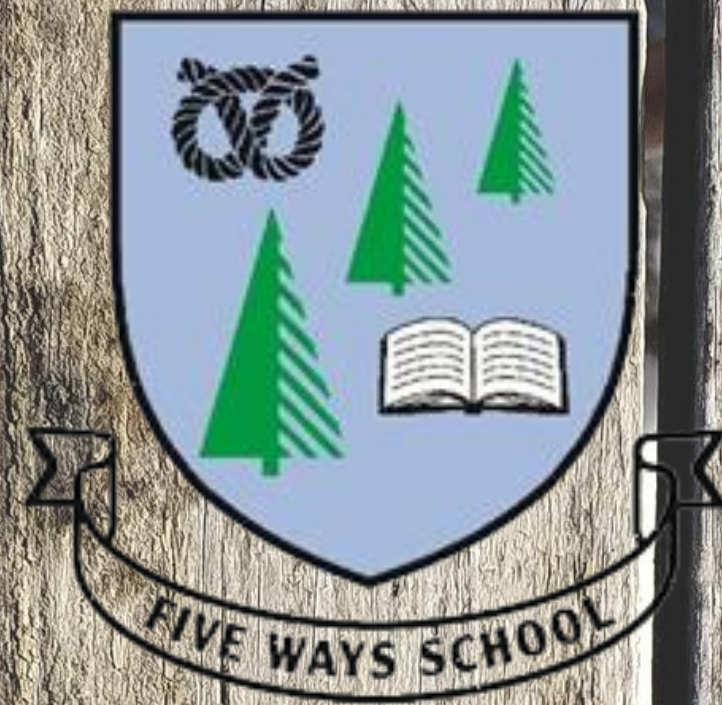




Welcome to Nursery

There is one large space, which can be split into two rooms when required, in addition to this space we have two smaller rooms which are designed for small group work, quiet times such as story time and yoga; as well as for sensory play and activities involving cooking.

All children will be assigned a key worker adult who will become your 'go to' adult should you need to share information or seek advice.

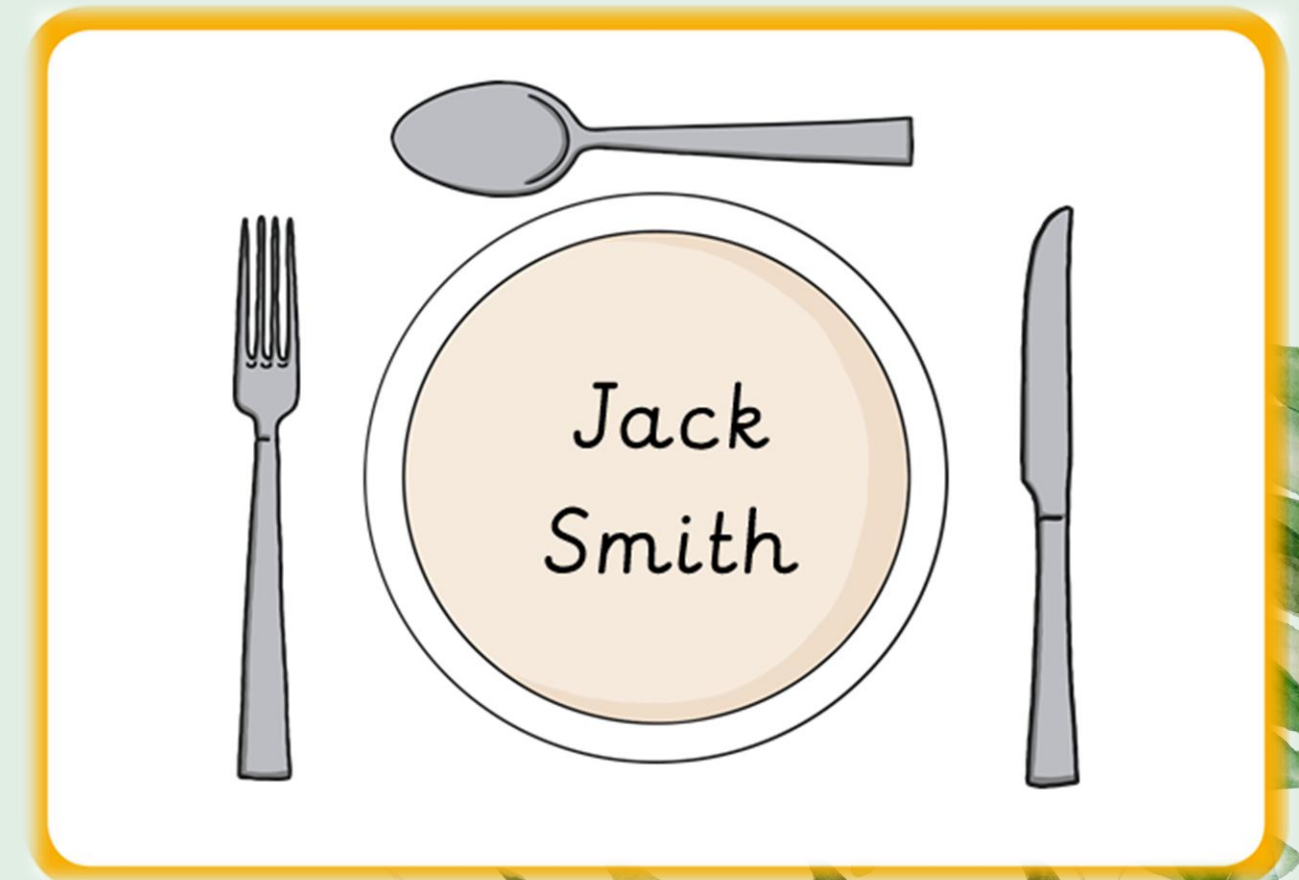

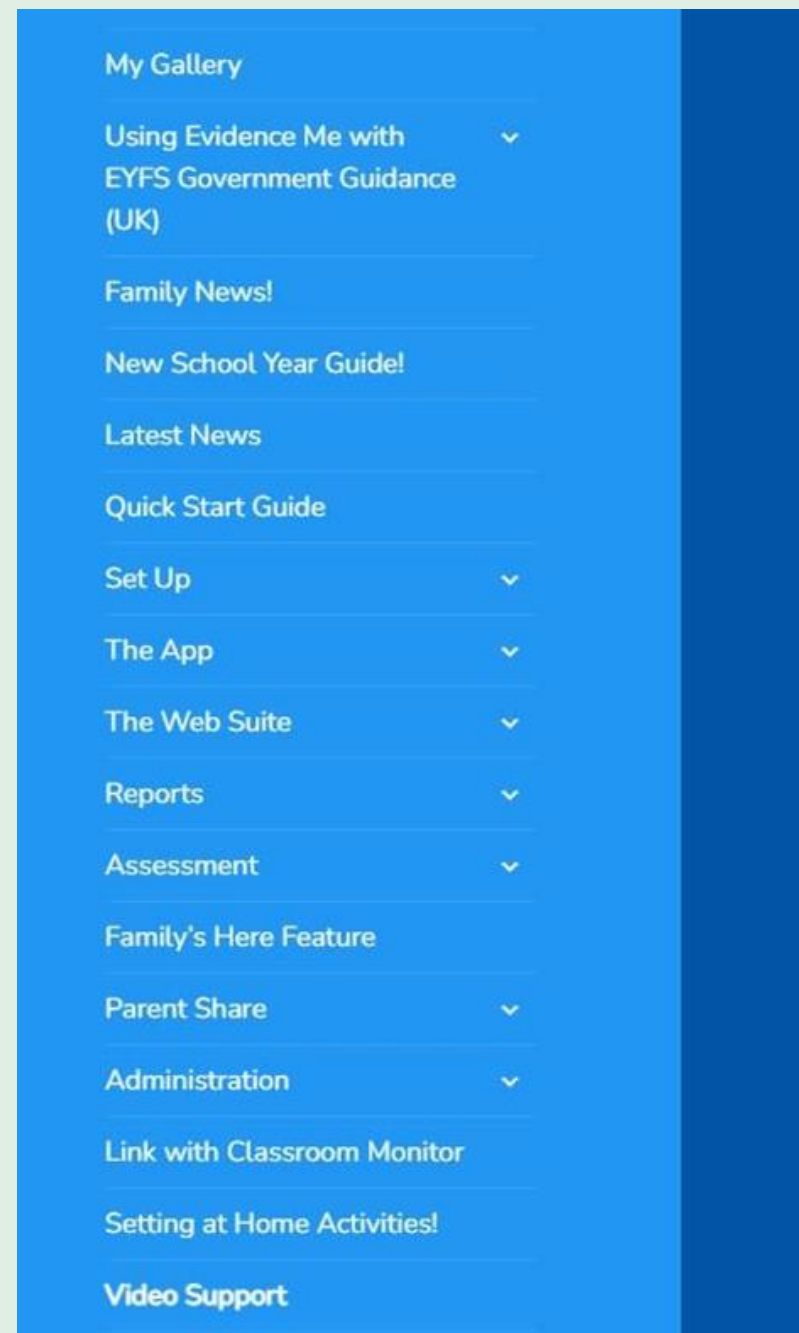
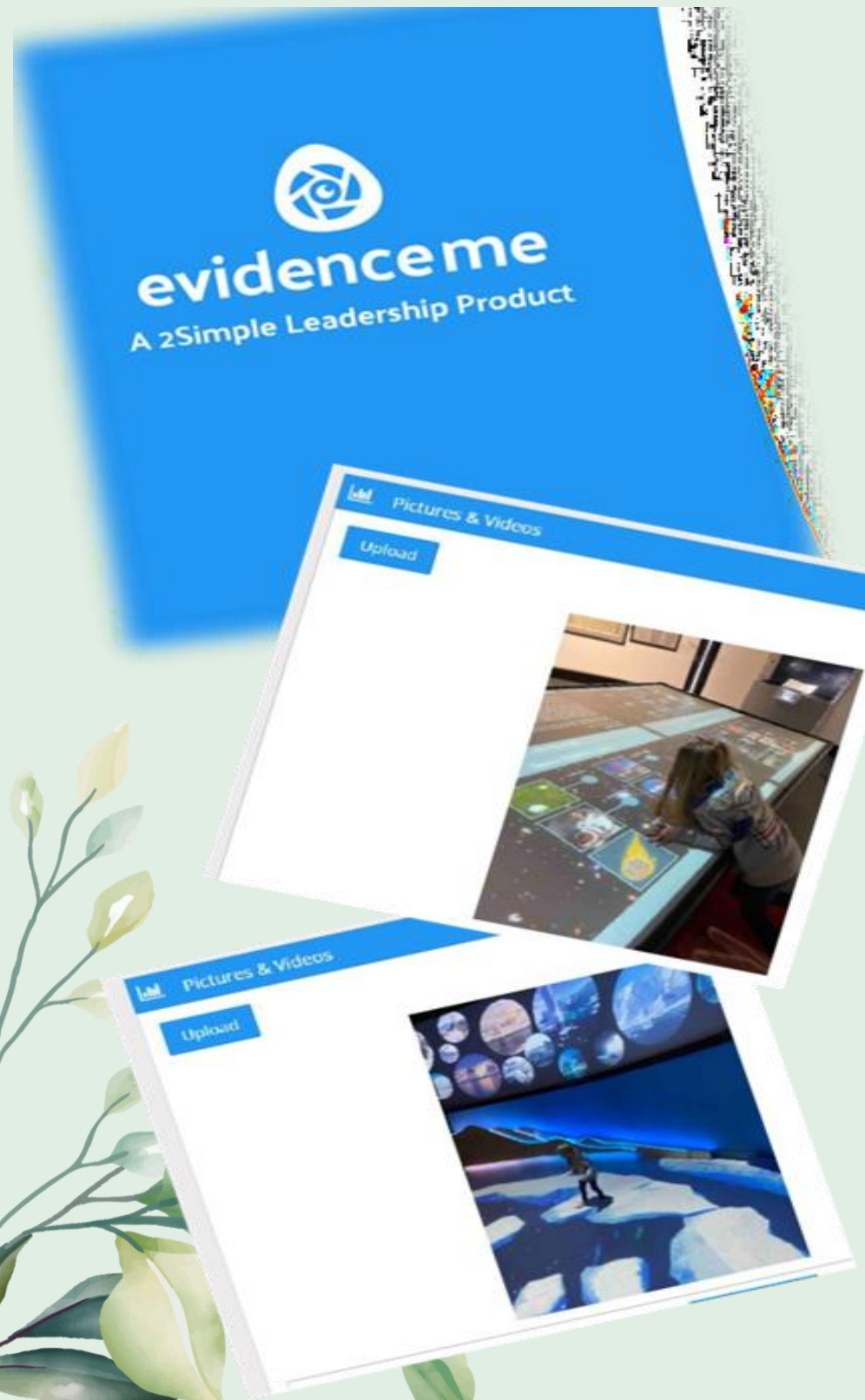

This video explains in detail the features and functionality of Evidence Me by 2Simple, including creating observations, creating profiles, and using reports.

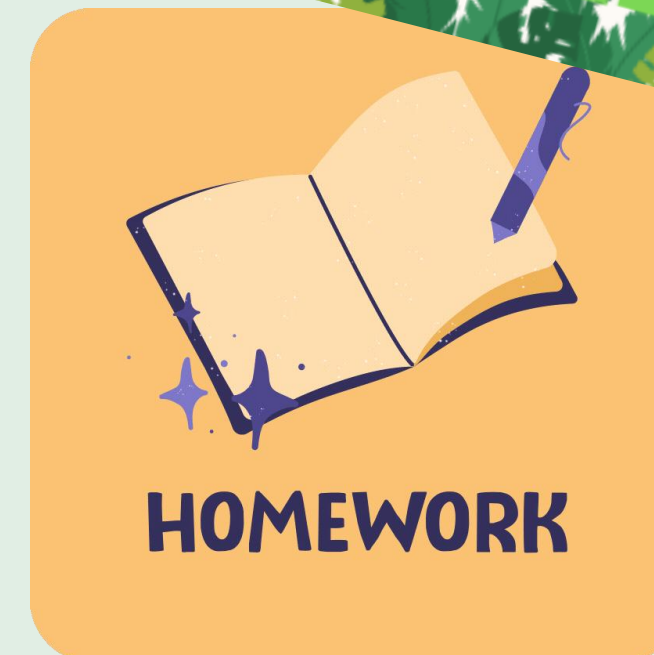

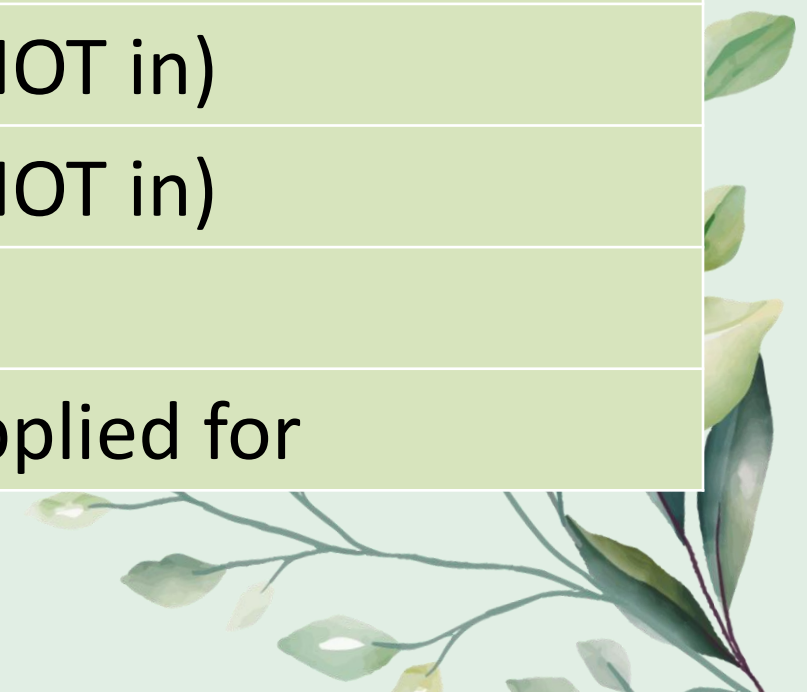

During the transition visits in July, you will be able to select a suitable day and time for your home visit.

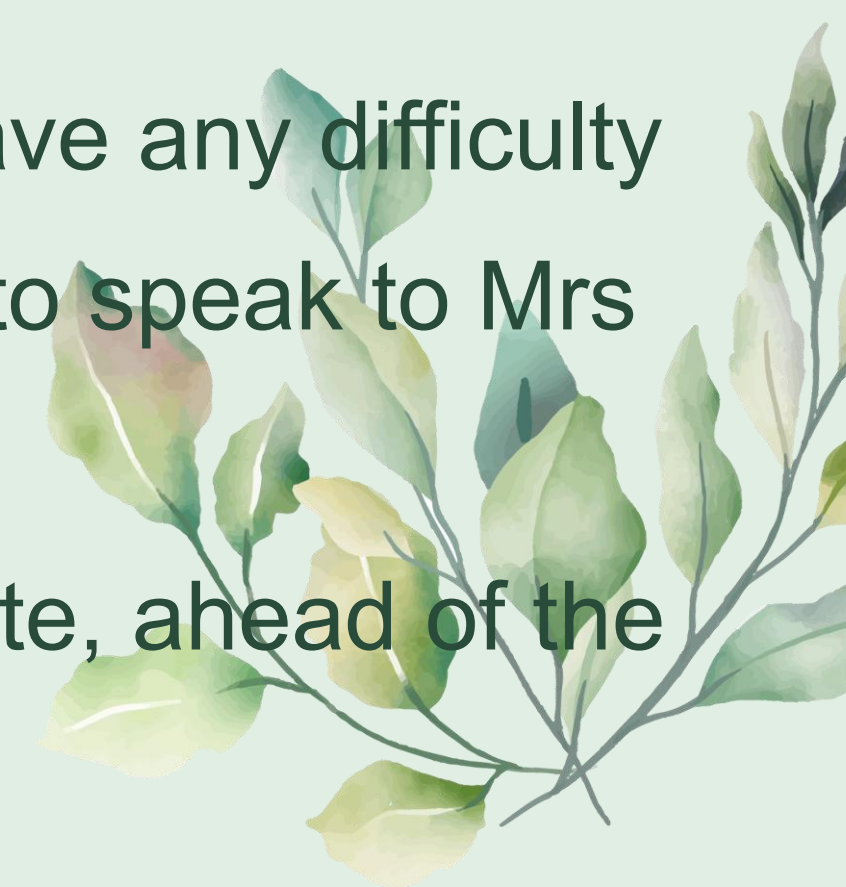
