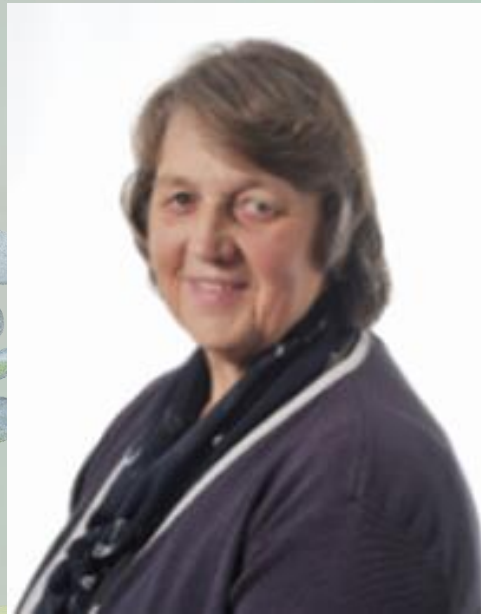

The Early Years Curriculum

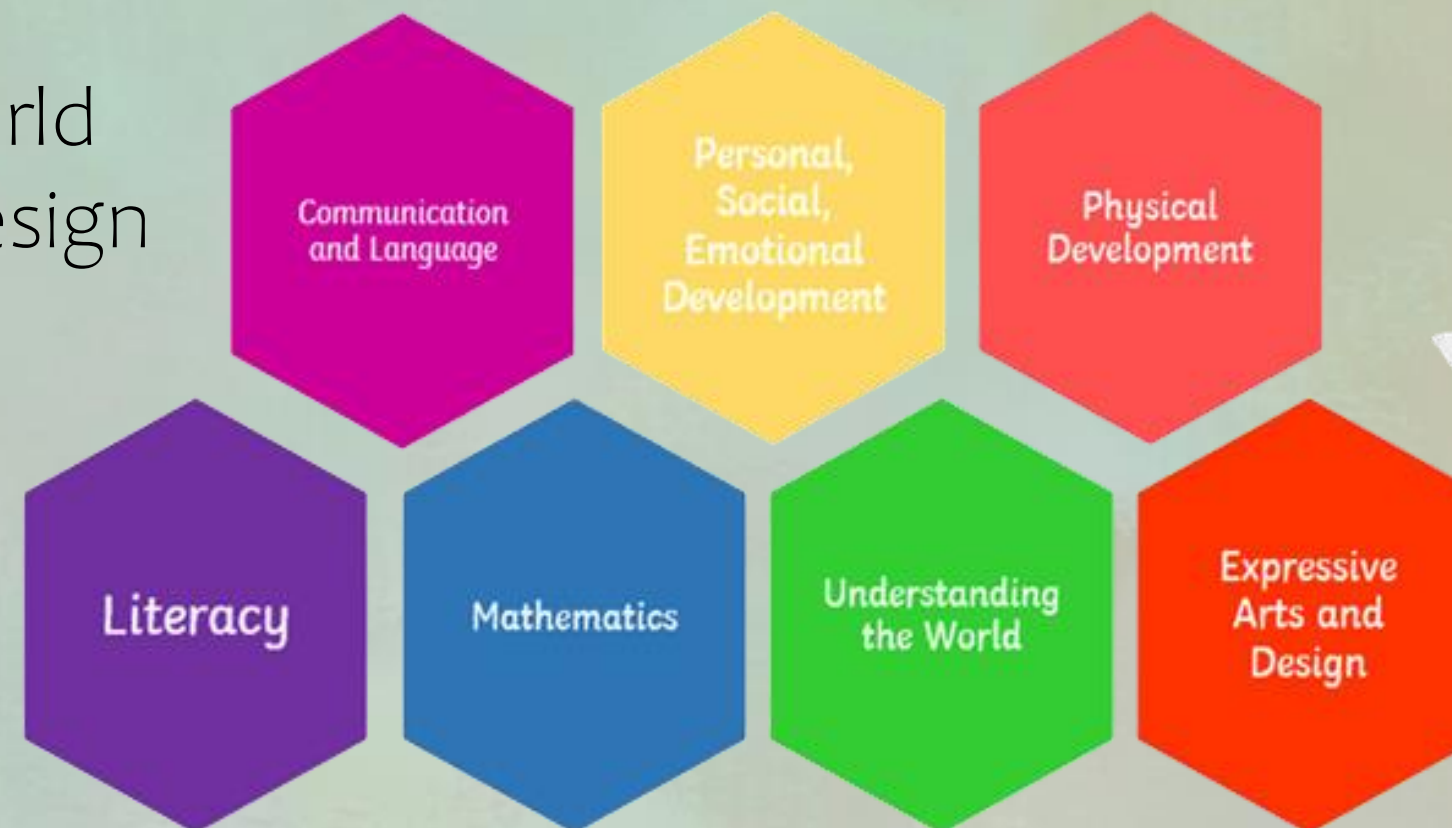
There are 7 areas of learning in the Early Years curriculum.

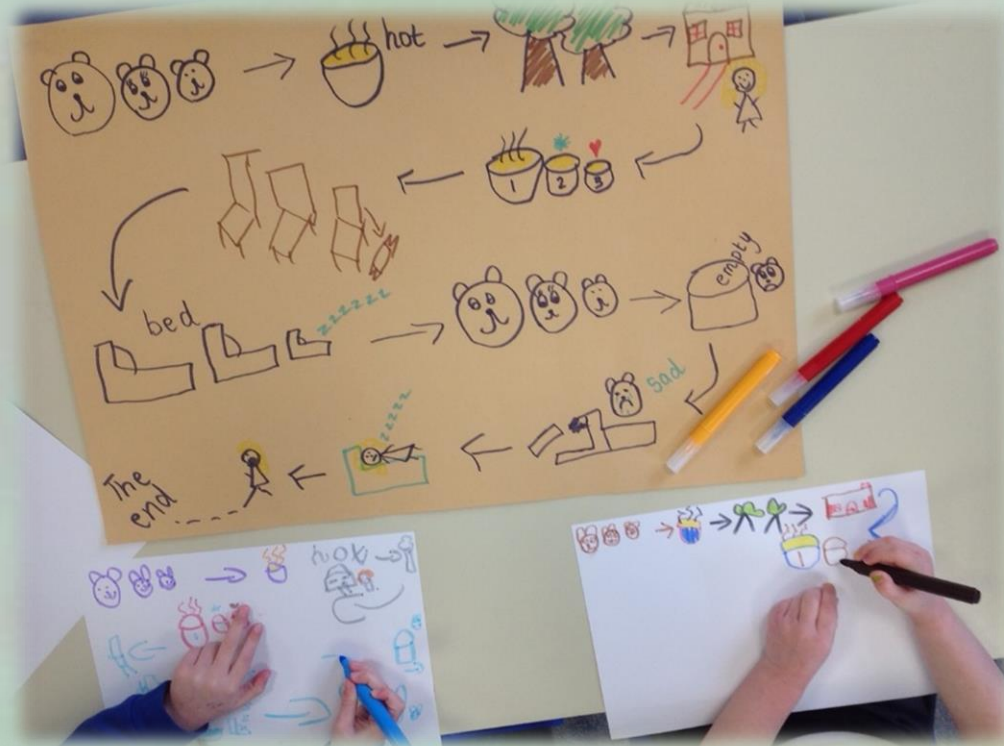
Extended Care Provision
