

Maths

In maths, we are studying geometry and statistics. We will identify amounts of turn when looking at images and objects, including whole, half and quarter turns. We will also use the terms 'clockwise' and 'anti-clockwise'. We will learn to interpret tally charts, bar charts and pictograms. We will answer questions about data, including 'How many?' and 'How many more?'.

You can help your child by challenging them to consolidate key Year 2 number skills: adding and subtracting any 2-digit number, calculating multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables, establishing halves, thirds and quarters of amounts.



English

During English lessons, we will adapt and retell a familiar story. We shall write descriptions linked to a book or theme. We will proof-read, edit and improve our writing.

You can help your child by encouraging them to practise their writing at home. We are happy to share any super short stories or reports, letters or holiday recounts with the class.



PSHE, HRE

During PSHE and HRE lessons, and during our daily assemblies, we will discuss being ready for changes in our lives.

You can help your child by discussing the transition from Year 2 to Year 3 and by helping them to recognise and celebrate all they have achieved personally and academically this year.

RE

In RE we will discuss 'morals' and 'values'. We will read and respond to stories that highlight the morals and values of believers and consider how they inform the actions of a believer. We will reflect on our own morals, values and actions.



Science

In science, we will investigate the survival needs of plants. We will find out how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.

You can help your child by including non-fiction texts about plants in their weekly reading.

Computing

In computing, we will link our learning to the maths curriculum. We will interpret and create simple pictograms.

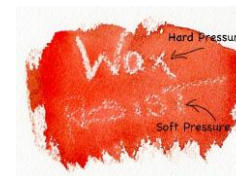
You can help your child by facilitating their safe use of the internet to find out more about plants (this term's science) and weather (this term's geography).



Geography

In topic, we will investigate our local weather patterns and establish our own Five Ways weather station.

Art

In art, we will experiment with wax resist techniques when painting.



Music

In Music, we will listen to and appraise music with a friendship theme. We will sing, play instruments, improvise and compose.



PE



In our PE lessons, we will learn gymnastics skills, including balances, core shapes, jumps and rolls. We will develop our running, jumping and throwing skills, ready for Sports Day.
