



Maths

In maths, we are continuing our work on decimals. We will flexibly partition, compare, order and round decimals including tenths and hundredths. We will also apply knowledge of decimals when converting, comparing, estimating and calculating with money. You can help your child at home by ensuring they continue to access TTRockstars regularly. Please check your heatmap regularly as we work towards the Multiplication Tables Check in June.



English

During English lessons, we will aim to use a wider range of punctuation accurately throughout our written work. This will include capital letters, full stops, question marks, exclamation marks, commas after fronted adverbials, apostrophes to mark singular and plural possession and inverted commas to indicate direct speech. We will plan and structure non-fiction texts effectively and write stories with a well-developed and well-paced structure.

You can help your child at home by encouraging them to discuss the key characteristics of the characters they come across in the stories they read. They should be able to comment on the effectiveness of an author's choice of language.



Citizenship (PSHE, HRE)

We will discuss habits we can adopt to ensure we have a healthy body and mind.

You can help your child by discussing the health of their body and their mind and by supporting in them in developing independent strategies for maintaining good health.



French (MFL)

We will learn some new vocabulary all about where we live and the rooms in our homes.

You can help your child at home by referring to the websites posted in Google Classroom.

RE

We will identify some of the ways in which religions name and describe attributes of God, and make links between beliefs and practice

You can help your child at home by discussing your family's beliefs and values, and how they impact on the way you conduct yourselves.



Science

We will investigate habitats and classify animals and plants within habitats. We will also consider the human impact on habitats.

You can help your child by encouraging their wider interest in science, for example, by finding out about animals and plants within particular habitats, e.g. polar, grasslands, forests, deserts.



Design and Technology

We will design and make a product including a pulley.

You can help your child by encouraging them to find out about famous designers and their products.



Computing

We will explore game creation and modify existing animations and games using repetition.

You can help your child by ensuring the games they play online are age-appropriate and they know how to report issues or concerns around online gaming.



History

We will investigate the Ancient Roman civilisation. We will find out about the Roman Empire and plot key events in the Roman invasion of Britain.

You can help your child at home by encouraging them to read non-fiction texts to find out more about the Romans and also stories from Roman mythology.



Art

We will draw and make artwork inspired by festivals and feasts.

You can help your child at home by encouraging them to read about artists past and present.



Music

We will sing, play instruments and improvise in response to gospel music.

You can help your child by encouraging them to listen to a wide range of musical genres.



PE

In PE, we are taking part in striking and fielding games. We will be developing athletics skills in preparation for sports day.

You can help your child by encouraging them to achieve the NHS's recommended daily hour of exercise.
