In maths, we are studying 'shape'. We will compare and order angles and recognise symmetry in polygons. In our study of 'statistics', we will interpret and draw line graphs. During our study of 'position and direction', we will plot co-ordinates and describe translation on a grid.

English

During English lessons, we will aim to use varied sentence openings, a wider range of conjunctions, extended noun phrases and a range of pronouns to avoid repetition. Choice of tense will be accurate and consistent throughout written work. We will plan and structure non-fiction texts effectively and write stories with a well-developed and well-paced structure.

You can help your child at home by ensuring they read a wide range of challenging fiction and non-fiction texts and continue to maintain a love of reading.



Citizenship (PSHE, HRE)

We will consider the challenges we face when coping with change as we prepare for the transition to Year Five.

You can help your child by helping them to reflect positively on all they have achieved within Year Four and how those skills will help them as they transition to Year Five.



French (MFL)

We will learn some new vocabulary all about where we live and the rooms in our homes.

RE

We will identify the main features and patterns of an act of worship and talk about the importance of worship for believers.

You can help your child at home by encouraging them to widen their awareness of the religions represented within British society, e.g. through reading non-fiction texts.



Science

We investigate the human digestive system. We will also interpret and draw food chains.

You can help your child by encouraging them to find out about the human body.



Design and Technology

We will design and make a product including a pulley.

You can help your child by encouraging them to find out about famous designers and their products.



Computing

We will explore game creation and modify existing animations and games using repetition.

You can help your child by ensuring the games they play online are age-appropriate and they know how to report issues or concerns around online gaming.



History

We will investigate the Ancient Roman civilisation. We will find out about the Roman Empire and plot key events in the Roman invasion of Britain.

You can help your child at home by encouraging them to read non-fiction texts to find out more about the Romans and also stories from Roman mythology.



Art

We will explore the art of display and consider how this affects the way artwork is seen.

You can help your child at home by encouraging them to experiment with different media when creating their own artwork at home.



Music

We will sing, play instruments, compose and improvise in response to the music of The Beatles.

You can help your child by encouraging them to listen to a wide range of musical genres.



PE

In PE, we are taking part in striking and fielding games. We will be developing athletics skills in preparation for sports day.
