Enrichment Experience

Due to the continued generosity of the PTFA, all pupils will be taking part in our annual 'Young Enterprise Scheme' during the course of the forthcoming weeks. This scheme forms part of our final enrichment day before the end of this term. The enterprise scheme will run over a series of days and aims to introduce pupils to the role that money plays in people's lives and to promote a basic understanding of enterprise. Each class will be given a start-up capital of £25 donated by the PTFA, to get their business up and running. Time will be given to investigate, plan, purchase, make, publicise, market and sell the products that pupils produce. Staff will support pupils to carry out an evaluation of their product and to calculate any profit or loss made. Profits made will be spent on a class reward, decided upon by the pupils and will be enjoyed before the end of this term. I know that pupils and staff will enjoy taking part in the project again and I know that pupils will gain a lot from the experience. Products designed and made by Foundation Stage and KS1 pupils will be available to purchase after school on Monday 8th July and KS2 products will be available to purchase during Open Evening on Thursday 4th July 6.00pm - 8.00pm. I look forward to keeping you informed of products that are going to be produced and ready for sale. Good luck to all classes and year groups!
