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International Day

We had a fantastic time last Friday when we took part in 'International Day'. Here are the photographs of everyone having an enjoyable time. Well done everyone!



Pupils in Nursery boarded our Five Ways Airlines flight 306 to Paris. The children had their boarding passes ready, sat beautifully, and listened to the inflight safety measures delivered by the cabin crew. After arriving safely, the children were taken to a Paris cafe where they enjoyed a traditional French breakfast.

Reception pupils learned all about Italy. Each class made some healthy vegetable and cheese pizzas, designed and made Venetian masks, learned about the colours and shapes found on the Italian flag, and learned how to say a few words and phrases in Italian.







Year 1 pupils enjoyed learning facts about India and making their own Indian flag. Pupils learned about the elephant festival, 'Jaipur'. They enjoyed watching videos of the festival and designing their own elephant for this special occasion. Pupils also enjoyed tasting some traditional Indian food. Each class took part in a dance workshop, which showcased some traditional Indian dancing.

Year 2 studied Japan as their country for International Day. Children made Japanese hachimaki headbands and carp kite flags using collage techniques. Year 2 pupils also had fun learning some Japanese greetings and some children tried to write their names in Japanese writing. Some children made an origami spinner or a samurai helmet while others played Japanese games, had a go at Sudoku and listened to Japanese stories.








Year 3 pupils learned all about China. They made an amazing, colourful dragon model using many art and design skills, including weaving a paper strip body to make the dragon flexible. Pupils learned about the beautiful characters used in Chinese writing and made a bookmark with their own name, written in red and gold.

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Year 4 pupils studied Greece. The children found out facts about the country and about the Greek flag. Children learned about the Greek theatre and made their own Greek theatre masks. They watched several short cartoons of some of the more famous Greek myths and then made models of some of the monsters from the stories, including Medusa, the Cyclops and the Minotaur. Children also found out about mosaics and created their own mosaic coasters using small coloured tiles.







As part of International Day, Year 5 pupils celebrated all things Mexico! Pupils took part in lots of fun activities including: Chocolate tasting, Mexican mask making, and Spanish classes.

Year 6 pupils spent the day studying Brazil, which also linked to their geography topic for this term. The pupils enjoyed a range of different activities including: tasting juices made from a variety of rainforest fruits, an alphabet research challenge using chrome books and an art activity inspired by rainforest animals.
