Attendance and Punctuality

Did you know that punctuality is linked to attendance? If your child is late to school and misses their mark in the register this counts as an unauthorised absence. If your child is just 5 minutes late to school 3 times a week it will add up to 2 days across the school year. Sadly, it has come to our attention that attendance in school is being affected by an increasing number of children arriving late on a regular basis.

In liaison with the County Council Education Welfare Department, we will be looking to address these issues with a targeted programme to improve attendance including 'late gates', letters and meetings with parents. This programme will be led by Mrs Russell, our School Business Manager and a member of the Senior Leadership Team, who has responsibility for attendance. Mrs Russell will be supported in this role by Mrs Hensley, our School Liaison and Support Officer.

Our aim is to support parents by raising awareness of the impact of good attendance and punctuality on your child's learning. Some parents will have already received letters concerning lateness and attendance and further letters and meetings will be planned for the New Year. Please help us to help your child by ensuring they arrive at school on time and ready for learning.
