be returned to school by Friday 1st March so that pupils can be consulted regarding how they feel the funds would be best spent to benefit them directly.


World Book Day

Bag2School

We will be holding our second Bag2School event on Tuesday 27th February. Bag2School is an organisation that helps to recycle good quality clothing, shoes and textiles. The items are weighed and taken away for recycling. The school receives a payment based on the weight of the materials collected. This is an ideal opportunity to go through your wardrobes and get rid of any outgrown things. Please see the flyer sent home today with more information.

For this event, we will be trialling a new 'Drop off Point' system. On Monday 26th February from 3.45pm – 5.00pm, the PTFA will be offering a 'Drop off Point' for donations that will take place at the main school gate entrance, off Langholm Drive. We would ask that you safely pull into the hatched area in front of the vehicle gate (vehicle gate will be locked) before getting out to unload your bags and leave them with the PTFA volunteers, who will then take them into school. This will save you having to bring donations on the morning of the event. We hope this organisation will encourage more families to take part in the recycling initiative. Alternatively, please ensure all donations are brought to school on Tuesday 27th February and placed under the canopy by the main office by 9.00am.
