Year 2 children celebrated World Book Day in style! They looked fantastic dressed up as their favourite fiction or non-fiction heroes. Year 2 based the week on the Roald Dahl story, '*The Giraffe and the Pelly and Me*'. They designed and described their own sweet that the character Billy could sell in his sweet shop. The children also learned about Joseph Coelho, a British poet and children's book author. They wrote a class poem based on some of his work.

The children studied the front pages of books and read the blurbs. They shared their thoughts on new and exciting titles and borrowed new and interesting reads from their class libraries. Year 5 children also studied 'Dragonology'. This is a magical non-chronological text that contains an array of information and beautiful illustrations of dragons. The children collected wonderful vocabulary and created the most amazing cinquain poems about these majestical beasts. The children enjoyed performing their poems to their classmates and completed the day by creating some amazing artwork to accompany their poetry.

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Year 6 children enjoyed writing and illustrating their own poetry entitled 'Where will my book take me?' inspired by the current Waterstone's Laureate, Joseph Coelho. Children also studied Joseph's book, 'Ten-Word Tiny Tales,' which creates a story in just ten words! The children then used an online word generator to create their own version.
