Access Protection Markings (H Bar White Line) Local residents along Langholm Drive, have had white lines painted on the roadside outside of their properties to prevent vehicles blocking their driveways. Access protection markings (APMs) also known as a 'H bar' are marked out with white lines and are used to identify vehicle access and make motorists aware that the access is required at all times of the day. If a vehicle blocks a driveway with an APM, the resident can contact the police on the non-emergency number 101. No vehicles can be made exempt from such enforcement, this includes the residents own vehicles. Please also be aware that the registration numbers of any vehicles parking illegally or inconsiderably, will be reported to the police. Please support us by following these regulations, allowing us to maintain good relations with our local residents.
