The online booking service will be available to access from **9.00am on Thursday 22nd January until Thursday 29th January at 4.00pm.** If you do not have internet access, it is still possible to make an appointment through the school office; please ring and discuss this with a member of the office staff who will book an appointment for you. If you wish to update your email address or mobile telephone number, please contact the school office.

7. Please click 'Book this Slot' to complete your booking. When the button has turned green you know your booking has been made.
8. At any time before Parents' Evening, you can click the link on your phone or email again to check your booking time.
